Ah, Capri. Such a classic that anything ultra-new would jar, which is why the revamp of the five-star Capri Tiberio Palace is spot-on. Its cool new look, with a nod to the Fifties and Seventies, couldn't be better. Antique furniture and *objets d'art* are livened up by graphic wallpapers and textiles and a refreshing aquatic palette that reflects the sunny island outside. Rooms are sublime, and the Taschen library is great to browse, but the most romantic spot is the Jacky Bar, evoking Sixties Cuba, with Panama hats decorating the walls, a white grand piano and knockout views of the Capri sunset.
